5.0 Hostels Accommodation

Hostel service is available at a cost of **150,000**/= per semester. Additional requirements for students residing in College's Hostel

- a) Pocket money for meals
- b) 1 mattress 3X6
- c) 2 Pairs of bed sheets
- d) Pillow
- e) 1 Mosquito net
- f) One bucket for laundry activities
- g) Other personal stuffs like laundry soap, toiletries, track suit for sports (blue colour), few pairs of casual clothes, sandals, sport shoes etc.

6.0 Cafeteria Services

The College has a standard cafeteria where students are served with various meals at affordable prices.

7.0 Uniforms

All students are supposed to buy or make their own uniforms. However, they should follow the requirements listed below:

a) FEMALES

- (i) Two decent white gowns. It must be thirty centimeters (30 cm) or more below the knees
- (ii) Flat black shoes (open shoes or sandals are not allowed)
- (iii)White socks
- (iv)Two white laboratory/clinical coats with long sleeves

b) MALES

- (i) Two white shirts with short sleeves
- (ii) Two pair of decent trousers- khaki colored (cotton materials). Jeans or tight/model trousers are strictly prohibited.
- (iii)Black leather shoes (open shoes or sandals are not allowed)
- (iv) White socks
- (v) Two white laboratory/clinical coats with long sleeves

8.0 Health Insurance

All students who possess valid Health Insurance cards (e.g., NHIF, Strategies, Jubilee etc.) should come with them and show them during registration.

IMPORTANT: Those who were not subscribed to any insurance plan, should pay for NHIF students' package of 50,400/= per year during registration process. (The fee may change subject to decision made by NHIF)

9.0 Supplementary/Special Examination Fee

For those students who failed the End of Semester Examination (either I or II) and allowed to sit for Supplementary Examination shall be required to pay 50,000/= for each Module. The fee shall also apply for special examinations (both end of semester or continuous assessments). The fee must be paid within fourteen (14 days) from the date the results are released or from the date the student postponed a scheduled examination and seek for special one.

10.0 Discipline

All students are supposed to demonstrate good behaviors within and outside the campus as prescribed in the students' bylaws. Failure to that shall subject the offenders to appropriate disciplinary actions.

11.0 Other items recommended for each student

The following items are recommended to each student

- a) Tanzania Pharmaceutical Handbook (TPH). An important manual book for each student. Available at a cost of 60,000/=
- b) One rim (A4 paper)
- c) A basic scientific calculator
- d) Four counter books (Q4) for taking personal notes
- e) Blue/Black Pens (about 15 pens per semester), 5 pencils, 1 ruler
- f) A basic smartphone to enable the student to access lecture notes and e-books on-the-go.
